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Dear Clive

I am writing to let you know that the Government has today published further monitoring data for the council tax rebate. This data shows the progress of the rebate payments as at the end of the day on 31 July.

This data is available alongside this previously published data [here](#) and is presented for England as a whole and also disaggregated at a local authority and constituency level.

All councils have reported making payments, including to those who do not pay council tax by direct debit. This data shows that as at the end of July over 16 million households had received the rebate, representing 86% of all households eligible for the rebate. Through the discretionary rebate scheme, councils have provided support worth £27m to around 550,000 households.

The Department intends to continue providing monthly monitoring data up to the end of the rebate scheme. I will of course alert you to further publications.
