As you are aware, the Government is working to secure continuity of the effects of EU trade agreements to enter into force at the end of the transition period.

The Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office leads on sixteen Association Agreements, which cover political, cooperation and trading relations, and fall within the Government's Trade Agreements Continuity programme. I am writing to inform you that the Prime Minister signed the UK-Ukraine Political, Free Trade and Strategic Partnership Agreement on 8 October.

This agreement replicates as closely as possible the effects of the existing EU and Ukraine Association Agreement. The agreement provides a framework for continued cooperation in foreign, security and political matters, while also securing continued preferential trade between the UK and Ukraine.

The agreement will now be subject to ratification, and we will therefore lay the agreement in Parliament for scrutiny in accordance with the requirements of the Constitutional Reform and Governance Act as soon as possible.

We have kept the Devolved Administrations, Crown Dependencies and Overseas Territories updated on the progress of discussions and shared a copy of the agreed in principle text with them.

I will keep you updated as further continuity trade agreements are signed.

I am copying this to the Chairs of the Foreign Affairs Committee and the House of Lords EU International Agreements Sub-Committee.
