COVID-19: Operational Information and Member-facing Services (S/19-21/42) **[RESTRICTED]**

The Committee was updated on the ways in which the Administration was responding to COVID-19 and took note of data relating to the operation of the Estate and the current provision of member-facing services provided in person on the Estate and remotely.

Parliamentary Health and Wellbeing Service: 2020 Review (S/19-21/43) **[RESTRICTED]**
