New transition review into imports of steel ropes and cables from China

I am writing to let you know that the Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) has [initiated a transition review](#) into anti-dumping measures on steel ropes and cables from China, including those products consigned from Morocco and the Republic of Korea. This measure covers steel ropes and cables including locked coil ropes and excluding ropes and cables of stainless steel.

The TRA's review begins on Thursday, 30 March 2023, and will look at the UK production of these products and levels of imports. The period of investigation (POI) for this transition review is 1 January 2022 until 31 December 2022 and the injury period is 1 January 2019 until 31 December 2022.

Businesses that may be affected by this review (such as importers or exporters of the products or UK producers of similar products) can contribute to the review process by registering their interest in the case on the [TRA's online case platform](#) by 17 April 2023.
