### **TRA initiates transition reviews into tyres from China**

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) has today [initiated two transition reviews into anti-dumping and countervailing measures](#) on lorry and bus tyres imported from China.

The tyres to be investigated during this review are pneumatic rubber tyres, new or retreaded and used for buses or lorries, with a load index exceeding 121.

As part of the transition review, the TRA will determine whether dumping of imported tyres or importation of subsidised tyres would be likely to continue or recur if the measures were no longer applied and whether injury to the UK industry would be likely to continue or recur if the measures were no longer applied.

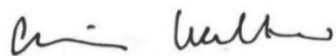
In addition, the TRA has recently published its initial findings in its investigation into imports of ironing boards from Turkey. The TRA is carrying out the investigation in response to a request from a UK manufacturer to investigate whether ironing boards imported from Turkey are subsidised and being sold in the UK at unfairly low prices.

The TRA's initial conclusions are published in a [Statement of Essential Facts](#) – companies which may be affected by the recommendation can comment on the findings by 29 May 2023 by registering on our online case platform.
