**1. COMMITTEE STRUCTURE: MANAGED PROCESS OF CHANGE
NOVEMBER 2020-MARCH 2021**

The Committee *agreed in principle* to appoint a successor European Affairs Committee.

The Committee *agreed in principle* to appoint a successor International Agreements Sub-Committee as a free-standing Select Committee for the remainder of the present Parliament.

The Committee *agreed in principle* to establish a committee on environment and climate change.

The Committee *agreed in principle* to establish a Committee on subjects relating to Growth, Regulators and Industrial strategy.

The Committee *discussed* the possible establishment of a new EU sub-committee, a committee on Justice and Home Affairs and a committee on housing and transport/the lived environment, and *agreed* to consider these matters further at their next meeting.

2. COVID-19 COMMITTEE

The Committee discussed the work of the COVID-19 Committee and *agreed* to the continuation of this Committee until November 2021, when the work of the Committee would be further reviewed.

3. ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE FOLLOW-UP INQUIRY
