Dear Secretary of State

I am writing regarding the Government's failure to respond to e-petition [639320](#), entitled "Find time to take the Clean Air (Human Rights) Bill through the House of Commons".

The standards for responding to e-petitions, which have been agreed between the Petitions Committee and the Leader of the House, state that Government responses should be provided within 14 days and no later than 21 days of being requested.

A response to this petition was first requested on 2 October 2023, and despite repeated requests, the Government's response is now over five weeks late. This is clearly not acceptable.

When a petition receives over 10,000 signatures petitioners are entitled to a response from the Government, and this should be provided in a timely fashion.

I would be grateful if you could provide the Government's response to this petition, and an explanation for the delay in providing this, by no later than Thursday 14 December.

I am copying this letter to the Leader of the House.
