**Update on geographical indications (GIs) in the UK-Japan Comprehensive
Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA)**

I am writing to update you on the progress of establishing protected status for some of the UK's most iconic products in Japan.

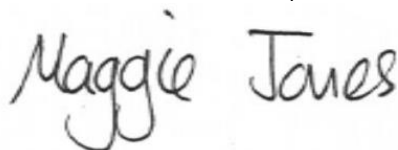
The Department for Business and Trade, along with officials from the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, have been working closely with Japanese officials to agree a date for entry into force of the necessary amendments to the CEPA, and both the UK and Japan have now completed the necessary technical and legislative processes for listing the second and final tranche of GIs in the agreement.

I am pleased to announce that 39 GIs will receive protected status on 20 December including renowned products such as Scottish Wild Salmon, several UK cheeses, Welsh Leeks, and Cornish Sardines, which join the 44 GIs already protected in our agreement.

The Department is working to ensure British producers can see the full benefits of the enhanced GI protection our agreement provides. Japanese GIs will also be protected in the UK under this agreement. I have included a full list of the UK products gaining protection as an Annex to this letter.

This is an important step in our bilateral trading relationship with Japan, reinforcing the importance of the CEPA and continuing to strengthen economic ties between the UK and Japan.
