Dear Ruth,

I am writing to you as Chair of the Transport Select Committee to update you on our plans in this area following our recent announcement on reviewing the law around powered mobility devices.

In the [Government's Advanced Manufacturing Sector Plan](#), which is part of the Industrial Strategy, we have committed to pursuing legislative reform for micromobility vehicles when parliamentary time allows. This will provide a proportionate and more agile process for regulating Low-speed Zero Emission Vehicles, likely including pavement delivery robots, e-scooters and last mile delivery vehicles. Creating a clear route to market will drive investment and usage in these new vehicles, unleashing businesses from the current regulatory burdens and kickstarting economic growth. Importantly, it will create safe, legal routes for people to use new transport technology and allow us to crack down on those who use them in an irresponsible and anti-social way. We will update you again when we have a clear timeline for when this legislation will be delivered.
