Dear James,

Invitation to give oral evidence regarding the draft Commonhold and Leasehold Reform Bill

As you are aware, my Committee is currently undertaking [Pre-legislative scrutiny of the draft Commonhold and Leasehold Reform Bill](#) at the request of the Government. It is important that the Committee hears from a wide range of stakeholders while undertaking this pre-legislative scrutiny. We are therefore keen to ensure that, alongside leaseholders, freeholders and institutional investors also have the opportunity to give evidence to us on the provisions in the draft Bill and how the proposed legislation may affect them.

Since the end of January, Committee staff have been in contact with Grosvenor's Corporate Affairs team regarding our invitation for Grosvenor to give oral evidence to the inquiry on the morning of Tuesday 3 March. I understand that Grosvenor's recent response has been that no executives are available to attend due to international commitments.

However, the Committee is still keen to ensure that, as one of the largest freeholders in England, Grosvenor's views are heard publicly. If you are unavoidably unable to attend on Tuesday 3 March, may I ask that Grosvenor provides another representative to appear before the Committee during the session? You are invited to give evidence alongside the Residential Freehold Association and TIME Investments.

I would be grateful for your confirmation of a representative's availability to give evidence in Parliament on Tuesday 3 March as soon as possible, and no later than Thursday 19 February. Committee staff remain available to discuss arrangements for your appearance. I look forward to hearing from you.
