Covid Vaccine Certificates

I wrote to you on 24th February, asking you to give evidence to the Public Administration and Constitutional Affairs Committee about the Government's plans for use of Covid vaccine certificates, based on media reports. You wrote back on 10th March, setting out some of the parameters for the review you are conducting and offering to give evidence after the review has concluded, which is no earlier than 21st June.

The debate on vaccine certification as moved on at pace in recent weeks, and given this changing context, I would like to ask you to appear before the Committee after the Easter recess. The Vaccines Minister has confirmed that Parliament will be given a vote on the introduction of vaccine certificates, but that will only be meaningful if Parliament has had the full opportunity to consider all the evidence and not just the Government review. My Committee has already taken evidence from some experts and has issued a call from written evidence, but we need to be able to put the points made to you directly.

I would be grateful if your office could liaise with the clerk to find a convenient date as soon as possible.
