Dear Dr Black,

I am writing on behalf of the Committee to follow up on our previous letter dated 7 April 2020 in connection with our ongoing inquiry into the FCO's role in blocking asset stripping in UK companies.

In addition to the questions we posed in the letter on 6 April, we would be grateful if you could answer the following additional questions:

- Does Imagination possess technology that could be used to detect and deter Cyber threats?
- Could technology currently in the possession of Imagination be utilised or weaponised in any way that could adversely impact UK Cybersecurity?
- Are investors in Canyon Bridge or China Reform aware of any such Cybersecurity technologies?
- Have Canyon Bridge or China Reform sought to in any way stall, cancel, redirect or otherwise influence development programmes in Imagination? If so, what programmes?
- Is Canyon Bridge or China Reform actively seeking to influence Imagination Technology's internal or external communications, including with the Foreign Affairs Committee?

It would be helpful to receive a response as early as possible, with, as previously mentioned, the possibility of an appearance before the Committee in due course.
