### **Initiation of a Transition Review of anti-dumping measures**

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) has today initiated a transition review (TD0013) of anti-dumping duties on certain aluminium road wheels originating from the People's Republic of China.

The matters we will consider during the review will include:

- whether the application of the anti-dumping amount is necessary or sufficient to offset dumping of the relevant goods in the UK market; and
- whether injury to the UK industry in the relevant goods would occur if the anti-dumping amount were no longer applied to those goods.

The review will involve inviting parties to register their interest in the review; issuing questionnaires to those parties; analysing information gathered; and publishing a Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) towards the end of the review. On publication, we will set a period of time, which will be no longer than 30 days, during which parties will be able to comment on the SEF and we will then make our recommendation to the Secretary of State for International Trade.
