HASC letter to Home Secretary on SR21


Thank you for your letter of 13 October about the Home Office's position in respect of the current Spending Review.

The Spending Review will conclude on 27 October. It will set departmental budgets for three years from 2022-23 to 2024-25 and the devolved administrations' block grants for the same period. How funding is allocated to individual departments will be confirmed by the Treasury at the SR publication on 27 October.

We have been working with HM Treasury to secure a settlement that delivers against our key outcomes, and I am sure we will cover this in the HASC's ongoing work, but I am not yet in a position to provide any definitive information on my Department's settlement.

The priorities for my Department for this Spending Review were analysed and developed with close reference to our Outcome Delivery Plan. Meeting the outcomes set out in our ODP will drive all of my Department's activity across the SR period and performance will be measured by reference to progress against those outcomes.

I would of course be happy to share further information with you on our settlement and spending plans once the official announcement has been made.
