TRA publishes Statements of Essential Facts on biodiesel measures

This letter is to let you know that the Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) has published its interim findings on [UK anti-dumping](#) and [countervailing](#) trade remedy measures which currently apply to biodiesel imports originating in the United States of America and/or consigned from Canada. These findings take the form of a Statement of Essential Facts.

The products investigated in our transition review include biodiesel produced from fatty-acid mono-alkyl esters (FAME) and biodiesel produced from paraffinic gasoil obtained from synthesis or hydro-treatment, of non-fossil origin (HVO). The TRA intends to recommend that the anti-dumping and countervailing measures on FAME are maintained, but that those relating to HVO are revoked.

UK and overseas industries have 30 days to review and comment on the findings before a final recommendation is made. We will then consider and produce a Final Recommendation, which will be sent to the Secretary of State for International Trade who will make the final decision on whether to uphold our recommendation.
