The conflict reveals the necessity of managing escalation, emphasising the MOD's eight defence tasks and nine Defence Lines of Development (DLODs). To support extended overseas operations, the UK Armed Forces must bolster strategic intelligence and logistics.

Russia's hybrid threats, combining conventional warfare with cyber-attacks and misinformation campaigns, require Defence Security and Resilience. The MOD must adapt to new tactical approaches, focusing on updated training and a credible nuclear deterrent. The UK's international defence engagement supports Ukraine, highlighting the need for strong Interoperability and Organisation DLODs. Logistics and Infrastructure must adapt to sustain overseas operations in challenging environments. Overall, the UK Armed Forces must adapt across multiple DLODs to maintain a robust defence posture in modern warfare.

### **Impact and Lessons of Drone Usage in the Ukraine Conflict for the UK Armed Forces**

The war in Ukraine has highlighted the significant role drones, or Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs), play in modern warfare. Their pervasive use by both Ukrainian and Russian forces has reshaped the battlefield, affecting strategies and operations, and raising implications for the UK Armed Forces. Drones have been used for surveillance, target acquisition, direct attacks, and coordination of artillery fire, demonstrating their versatility and operational impact.

### **Types of Drones and Tactical Applications**

Combatants in the Ukraine conflict have deployed a range of drones, from commercial off-the-shelf products to sophisticated combat drones like the Bayraktar TB2, used for strategic-level capabilities in surveillance, targeting, and strike coordination. This deployment spectrum underscores the need for robust equipment and a diverse understanding of drone applications, aligned with the Defence Lines of Development (DLODs). Drones have become key to

### **Strategic Impact and Force Protection**

The use of drones has had a profound effect on battlefield dynamics, contributing to force protection through persistent surveillance and early warning against surprise attacks. These challenges require robust Training and Information management to ensure resilience against counter-UAV tactics.

This visibility impacts the Information and Strategic base and enabling functions, emphasising the need for effective media management and strategic communication. The UK's international defence engagement must consider the implications of drone warfare on public relations and partnerships, highlighting the importance of a cohesive approach to information management.

### **Comparative Analysis and Gaps Identified**

The extensive deployment of drones in Ukraine reveals potential gaps in the UK's drone utilisation strategy, particularly in versatility and electronic warfare countermeasures. The versatility demonstrated in drone operations suggests the need for adaptable Concepts & Doctrine, advanced Equipment, and improved Information systems. Interoperability with allies and partners is crucial for joint operations, while robust Logistics and Organisation are required to support sustained drone operations.

### **Recommendations for Strategic Adjustments**

To address the evolving role of drones in modern warfare, the UK Armed Forces should:

- ⊠ Invest in research and development to maintain a strategic edge in drone technology.
- ⊠ Revise military doctrine to incorporate the tactical and operational flexibilities afforded by drones.
- ⊠ Enhance alliances for intelligence sharing and coordinate interoperable drone systems.
- ⊠ Strengthen cyber defences and improve logistical frameworks for rapid deployment and sustained support for drone operations.
- ⊠ Innovate infrastructure to accommodate drone maintenance and housing.

These recommendations, derived from lessons learned in Ukraine, emphasise the need for the UK Armed Forces to adapt across all areas of defence planning and capability development.

The UK Armed Forces must expand investment in space capabilities, focusing on advanced satellite communication systems and space surveillance technology. Strengthening resilience against space-based threats is also critical, requiring robust Interoperability practices among allies and an emphasis on cybersecurity.

The impact of space domain activities on public perception and international diplomacy cannot be understated. The widespread dissemination of satellite imagery has influenced public opinion and shaped international narratives, impacting the Defence Tasks related to Influence through International Defence Engagement and the Strategic Base and Enabling Functions. This dynamic requires the UK Armed Forces to engage in shaping international space norms and regulations while maintaining robust cyber defences to protect against emerging threats.

### **Escalation Management Lessons from the Ukraine Conflict for the UK and NATO**

The Ukraine conflict has provided crucial lessons for the United Kingdom (UK) and the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) on managing escalation. It underscores the importance of the UK Ministry of Defence's (MOD) eight defence tasks and nine Defence Lines of Development (DLODs), which are vital for shaping strategic and operational responses.

### **Strategic Context and Implications**

deterrence and provocation, emphasising the importance of understanding and mitigating risks related to misinformation and cyber warfare.

The operational implications for the UK and NATO defence postures are significant. The war in Ukraine is a reminder that conflicts can escalate quickly, necessitating enhanced preparedness, agile response capabilities, and continuous assessment of the Strategic Base and Enabling Functions. The MOD's task of defence security and resilience requires robust Infrastructure to ensure continuity of command and support functions in hostile conditions. The Organisation DLOD must be adaptable to meet the demands of uncertain security environments.

### **Operational Lessons Learned**

The operational challenges observed in the Ukraine conflict have provided valuable insights into managing escalation. The resilient command and control (C2) structures are essential, as evidenced by the importance of secure, redundant, and agile information systems. This reinforces the need for interoperability among allies to ensure coordinated force management. The decentralisation of decision-making has proven critical for rapid and effective responses to the changing nature of modern combat.

The strategic and operational impact of timely and flexible force deployment and manoeuvre is a key takeaway from the Ukraine conflict. The MOD has gained insights into the value of high-readiness units and pre-positioning forces, highlighting the role of the Logistics DLOD. The importance of Equipment that is both resilient and adaptable to different threat environments is emphasised, reinforcing the need for robust logistical support.

The conflict has also tested the rules of engagement (ROE) and force proportionality principles. Adhering to these norms is crucial for managing escalation, ensuring that military actions are legitimised by international law and ethical warfare principles. Training programs focusing on various scenarios in line with these updated doctrines are vital for maintaining a credible and legally grounded military posture.

## **Tactical Advancements and Setbacks**

This shift in tactics necessitates strategic adjustments in the MOD's Concepts & Doctrine, Training, and Infrastructure to combat these threats.

Resilience task, requiring a re-evaluation of Logistics and Organisation to ensure robust supply chains. Political interference through cyber operations has highlighted the need to reinforce Information operations and counter disinformation. The MOD's defence policies must adapt to these hybrid threats, with a focus on agility and resilience.

### **Future Threat Landscape and Defence Strategy**

The evolving hybrid threat demands a UK defence strategy that is both adaptive and forward-looking. The war in Ukraine has shown the necessity for strategic adjustments to counter these threats, focusing on enhancing strategic intelligence, bolstering cyber defence systems, and promoting robust Interoperability with allies. Recommendations include increased investment in information resilience, modernisation of cyber defence, and enhancing the direct defence capabilities against unconventional threats. These strategic adjustments ensure that the UK's defence posture remains resilient and adaptable to evolving hybrid threats.
